

Table in the Wilderness presents:

2012 TWM Do-It-Yourself Open Hunting Camp!

Sure it seems like it's a long way off but hey, if you want to hunt Wyoming this fall, you gotta get crackin' now! Elk application deadline has already passed and antelope application deadline is March 15. If you draw any tag for any species in our area we'd love to be your base of operations. This year we'll be hosting the do-it-yourself hunts for a variety of species and weapons starting Aug 31 and running through September 23. Make your plans and start assembling your gear, it'll be here before you know it!

We'll be basecamping at our new lodge facility in the Snowy Range Mountains near Centennial, WY. We're located about 27 miles west of Laramie on HWY 130. Turn left at the Table in the Wilderness sign just uphill from the town of Centennial. The lodge is just up that road, on the left. Our back property line is the Medicine Bow National Forest with hundreds of thousands of acres of wilderness to explore! To open up as many options as possible, we've set a minimum three-night stay with all meals included for \$299/person. Additional days can be reserved by advance arrangement at \$75/per day (lodging and food).

IMPORTANT NOTE: This is a **do-it-yourself** hunt. TWM is not licensed as an outfitter and accordingly we are not legally permitted to provide guide or outfitter services. We encourage you to do your homework! Research, investigate, plan...after all isn't that a big part of the fun? What we can and will do is provide an extremely affordable big game hunting camp experience with great Christian fellowship. Our desire and purpose is to serve you in your hunt and to help you grow closer in your relationship with Jesus Christ during your time here with us at the Table!

Our facility is in Antelope Unit 45. Many of our past hunters have enjoyed great success in the adjoining Antelope Unit 43 as well. Nearby Elk units include 10 and 11. Remember this is big country, expect drive times of up to 1.5 hours to the far points in hunting units closest to us. We'd suggest you investigate the Hunter Management Area program (see link below) which provides access to private lands. Increase your odds for success and enjoyment by doing your hunt planning and contacting landowners (if applicable) in advance.

TWM will provide:

- home-cooked meals (full suppers; full breakfasts; field/sack lunches)
- lodging (including main lodge with bunkhouse-style sleeping quarters; dry cabins, rv sites, hot showers)
- game processing area for do-it-yourselfers (hoists, tables, refrigeration for processed meat); contact info for area meat processors for those who prefer to have their harvest professionally processed
- devotional/sharing speakers as available
- assistance with anything that makes this a more memorable, life-changing experience

YOU provide:

- transportation
- hunting gear
- sleeping bag/bedroll; pillow; towel/washcloth
- license, hunt area maps (available online through WYGFD)
- fishing gear, spinning or flyfishing, great trout fishing nearby for those who tag out or want a change of pace day
